# Religious Education

Morality and Justice - Stewardship and Creation

The students will:

- investigate what the Catholic perspective says about stewardship
- make connections between our Catholic story of Creation and the Wurundjeri Creation story
- make judgments about environmental issues and how they affect life on earth
- evaluate ways that they can respond to local environmental issues as a steward of God's Creation

The students will:

### Focus:

Students will:

- use the design process to create their own product using up-cycled materials

### **English / Reading and Viewing**

Students will:

- ask rich questions (inferencing & evaluative) related to the text before reading, during reading the text and after reading the text
- Explore the language features of a persuasive text. E.G. You must buy this! You need this!
- Compare and evaluate two texts presenting the same idea and analyse which text was more engaging to the reader

# Focus Text Types: Poetry, Persuasive

Students will:

- explore a range of persuasive texts
- demonstrate understanding of the purpose of each of these texts
- use the appropriate text structures, features and language to plan and compose a persuasive text in the form of an advertisement
- includes a range of adjectives and verb groups to create more complex sentences when writing
- Include figurative language in their writing where relevant

Students will:

- explore verb tenses, conjunctions and connective adverbs
- continue to explore how to effectively use action verbs, adjectives and adverbs

- Apply different suffixes to base words
- Identify misspelt words in their own writing.
